Aberdeen Airport to unveil new WDF retail area in 2018

A new World Duty Free retail space is set to arrive at Aberdeen International Airport (ABZ) next year, the airport has announced.

The new store, which will be accompanied by an enlarged and improved security area, forms part of the second stage transformation of the airports terminal.

Once complete, a third and final phase will focus on the realignment of the airside-landside boundary, an improved departure lounge and upgraded retail and catering facilities, all set to open in 2019.
