

Augustin de Romanet is re-elected ACI President

Augustin de Romanet has been re-elected as ACI President for a second term of office at this week's 26th ACI EUROPE Annual Assembly and Congress.



In a mini-speech, de Romanet who is also President & CEO of Aéroports de Paris S.A.- Groupe ADP, said he was grateful for the continued trust placed in him by the voting members.

"It is a great honour to be re-elected to chair ACI EUROPE. There is still a lot of work ahead of us to make European aviation and, in particular, European airports, an asset to foster the European economy.

"In that exciting context, I will keep on doing my best to be available, to guide the Board and the Association, to educate decision makers and to defend the interests of our industry. My priority at all times will be to continue to ensure that we defend the collective interests of all our members, whatever their size or location. I will also work to ensure greater association with our World Business Partners.
